1. Passage of the High School Exit Exam in English and Math
2. High School Subject Requirements
 

English .....	40 credits
Health .....	5 credits
World History 10 credits .....	10 credits
U.S. History .....	10 credits
American Government & Economics .....	10 credits
Physical Education .....	20 credits
Science (Physical – 10 and Life – 10) .....	20 credits
Mathematics (including Algebra 1) .....	30 credits
Visual and Performing Art/Foreign Language .....	10 credits
3. **Total credits required.....220 (or more)**
4. **Senior Internship/Portfolio**

## COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

**COMMUNITY COLLEGE** – admission requirements are graduation from high school, a minimum age of 18 years, or passing the California High School Proficiency Exam.

**CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY** – admission requirements include:

1. Grade point average based only on high school subject requirements "A – G" (listed below). All courses must be passed with a C grade or better.
2. Test scores on either SAT or ACT
3. High school subjects required:
 

"A" World History .....	1 year	= 10 H.S. credits per year
"A" U.S. History/American Government .....	1 year	"
"B" English .....	4 years	"
"C" Mathematics (including Algebra 2) .....	3 years	"
"D" Lab Science (Biology 1, Chem or Sierra lab sci, etc.) .....	2 years	"
"E" Foreign Language (including 2 <sup>nd</sup> yr of same language) .....	2 years	"
"F" Visual and Performing Arts .....	1 year	"
"G" College preparatory elective .....	1 year	"

**UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA** – admission requirements include:

1. Grade point average based only on high school subject requirements "A"- "G" (listed below). All courses must be passed with a C grade or better. A grade of "D" in a required high school subject will disqualify an applicant unless he/she has retaken the subject and earned a "C" or better.
2. Test scores on either SAT or ACT
3. High school subjects required:
 

"A" World History .....	1 year	= 10 H.S. credits per year
"A" U.S. History/American Government .....	1 year	"
"B" English .....	4 years	"
"C" Mathematics (including Algebra 2) .....	3 years	"
"D" Lab Science (Chemistry, Biology, Physics) .....	2 years	"
"E" Foreign Language (including 2 <sup>nd</sup> yr of same language) .....	2 years	"
"F" Visual and Performing Arts .....	1 year	"
"G" College preparatory elective .....	1 year	"

**PRIVATE AND OUT OF STATE COLLEGES** – admission requirements are generally similar to the CSU and UC systems. Students should make contact with individual institutions to confirm specific requirements.
