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Introduction

The 20 Time Project is a student directed investigation into a topic that interests them. Working independently or in groups, the student must find a real world problem connected to their topic and create a project that addresses the problem. The project itself can take many forms and provide an opportunity for students to develop new skills. While a great deal of class time will be dedicated to work on the project, students might have to work on their project outside of class as well. At the end of the class, students should have a completed project. The culminating assignment is a TED style talk given to the student body about the project.

Plagiarism

Academic honesty is of the utmost importance, as a result, plagiarism is not to be tolerated. Plagiarism is most simply defined as copying someone else's work. If while doing your homework, you copy a classmate's assignment and turn it in as your own work, both you and the person allowing you to copy have committed plagiarism. If while writing a research paper, you copy information from text word for word or you use an author's ideas and pass them off as your own without giving credit to the author, you have committed plagiarism.

The consequences for plagiarism during your four years at Ghidotti are as follows:

1st Offense: You will receive a zero on the assignment with no chance to make up the points

2nd Offense: 5 days suspension

3rd Offense: Expulsion

Tardies
